IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS – PROPOSED MANAGEMENT CONTRACT

DRSL is a large regional registered club based in Dubbo. DRSL has the staff, expertise and resources to assist WSC with the management of its licensed premises and registered club business located in Wingham. The parties are considering undertaking an amalgamation, subject to formal requirements of the Registered Clubs Act 1976 (NSW), approval of each of the parties' members and approval of the Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority. Although the management contract is not subject to completion of an amalgamation, it is entered into to assist WSC remain financially viable and assist in seeking to improve revenues/cash flow pending a possible amalgamation being pursued.

Members are advised that the club is required to lodge a report with Liquor & Gaming NSW to enable a review of the proposed contract for compliance with the legislation. Following that review, Liquor & Gaming NSW may issue a direction to not to enter into, or amend, the contract if it is of the opinion that it does not comply with the Registered Clubs Act 1976, the Registered Clubs Accountability Code within the Registered Clubs Regulation 2015 or it is not in the interests of the club or its members.
